

by the glass

we do not have a "house wine."

in europe, a "house wine" is a glass or carafe of wine made from the local grape. it can be quite delicious...or it can taste like turpentine. in the united states, the definition of a "house wine" is a basic, everyday, not particularly special, inexpensive offering purchased in a large format. or, in restaurant speak, *the cheapest wine we could get our hands on to sell off for a major profit to people who don't know any better.*

that is not how we roll at perrones.

we care way too much about our guests. every wine that is on our list, glass or bottle, is personally tasted and selected to enhance your experience. it's a tough job, but somebody has to do it!

we pour a healthy 6 oz. of wine into a 20 oz. crystal glass.

by the glass 'reserve'

**all reserve wines are 3 oz. or 6 oz. pours
kept in a temperature, humidity controlled unit.
white wines are stored at 47.* red wines are stored at 61.*
all are dispensed with the coravin system.**

the coravin wine preservation system allows you to pour wine from a bottle without removing the cork. a thin, non-coring, medical grade needle passes through the cork to access and pour the wine. as the wine is dispensed into the glass, the bottle is replaced with inert argon gas. oxygen never enters the bottle, so no oxidation or deterioration of the wine ever occurs. when the needle is removed, the cork reseals and continues to protect the wine indefinitely, assuring the same level of quality again and again.

the coravin system will allow our guests to sample and enjoy highly allocated, rare, and aged wines that were previously too cost prohibitive to open and serve by the glass.
the coravin has revolutioned how we can experience wine.

well-structured, with a rich savoriness to the asian pear and apple flavors. citrus and pastry accents on the engaging, fresh tasting finish. • 90 pts. wine spectator

elegant, assertive nose of white flowers and citrus fruit. on the palate, a structured wine, well balanced between minerality and acidity, with almond notes on the finish. 93 pts. wine enthusiast

steely aromas with a smoky, creamy edge. minerals, roasted white almonds and green stone fruit. pretty full-bodied and bright, with a flavorful and clear center palate. a nice touch of phenolics and salinity at the end adds a bit more gravity to the wine. 95 pts. james suckling

100% sauvignon blanc produced from 58-year-vines. acid forward with a perfumed nose of pear, green apple, acacia, white peach, and lemon zest. the wine is fresh, bright, and youthful with racy acidity and fruit bounce on the finish

only 100 cases produced from four barrels: two from putnam vineyard on the sonoma coast, one from van der kamp on the sonoma mountains, and one from the platt vineyard. boysenberry, blueberry, and fresh dates marry with sweet plum, basil, and fresh bay leaf. • 93 pts. james suckling

syrah:

champagne & sparkling

independent grower champagne: aka "farmer's fizz"

*these are sparkling wines made in the champagne region of france that are produced by the same estate that **owns** the vineyards from which the grapes come. this allows for a hands-on production and that chain of agricultural accountability (**think farm-to-table**). it has the kind of singularity of character that, say, a single barrel bourbon does. if it all comes from a handful of acres on the same vineyard, there's a sense of micro terroir, or "**authenticity of place**". whereas those larger 'branded,' houses can source their grapes from over 19,000 different vineyards in the champagne region. some big brands blend grapes from up to 1000 vineyards. that's a lot of moving parts.*
